The IAGSDC has updated its website with a new host. If you had a profile on the previous site, they were able to port most of the information across. However, they could not bring the passwords from the old system. So, if you haven't already, I suggest you activate your account using the following steps:

- Go to https://iagsdc.org/
- Go to menu option Members/Member Login
- At the bottom, enter your account name (it will be the same as the old ID)
- Then click on Request a new password
- This will trigger an email, which will allow you to enter a new password
- From then on, it should remember your name and password

Once you're active again, verify these items were ported correctly, and are upto-date

- Check the contact details in your profile
- Update your current dance level and club affiliation (this helps organizers of the conventions and fly-ins for planning purposes)
- Check that your expected registrations are still there and in paid status

This is also an excellent opportunity to register for the Triangle Squares Fly-in, Pearl Promenade, **May 2018**, at the early-bird price.

Here are the future conventions for those who like to plan and book ahead:

- 2018 Jul 4-8: Circle Back to Seattle
- 2019 Jul 4-7: Belles Run Philadelphia

Also, under convention planning, I highly recommend the Canadian National Convention, next summer. It will be held in London, Ontario, **July 19-21**, **2018**. The 2014 convention in Ottawa was lots of fun. Registration is available through the convention website.
